## Banners





1. Hanging: You do not want your banner to droop in the middle. We also suggest that you do not stretch your banner too excessively so as not to rip out the grommets and/or corners. Hanging against a wall or a flat surface works very well.



4. TRANSPORTING / STORING: Always roll your banner with the lettering on the outside. This will keep the lettering from "tunneling"; little ripples of material that will cause the letters to come off or come loose if the banner is rolled the improper way.



2. We recommend either weaving a nylon rope through the grommets and tying off the corners, or using a 1/4" cable (or larger if needed) and closable chain links across the top of the banner, with a bungee cord securing the bottom two corners for wind resistance. Make sure the tension is in the rope and not straining the banner.

3. CLEANING: You may clean your Signs Now banner with a mild detergent.



5. Folding your banner will cause the letters to stretch and lose their shape. We recommend rolling your banner around a 5" cardboard core to keep it in it's best shape.



Remember:

DO NOT FOLD!

STORE AROUND A TUBE USING A RUBBER BAND TO HOLD THE BANNER - DO NOT USE TAPE!
